

Georgia ASTA SUMMER ORCHESTRA CAMP

Checklist of things to bring:

I. **Clothes:** Shorts, jeans, t-shirts, and other casual items may be worn. If you are in doubt please adhere to your school dress codes. *Shorts and the camp T-Shirt will be dress for the concert.* Bring a light weight jacket and pants in case of cool weather. Socks and comfortable shoes. *Swimsuit--pool shoes, beach towels.* Rain gear - umbrella or poncho.

II. **Linens:** Bedding – Pillow, twin sized sheets, blankets or a *sleeping bag* (a sheet is also nice inside the sleeping bag when it's hot, even in the air conditioning). Towels, beach towel, and a washcloth.

III. **Bathroom Articles:** Soap and shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrush, blow dryer, various hair goo, etc.

IV. **Miscellaneous:** Insect repellent, *sunscreen*, flashlight, alarm clock, camera & teddy bear! A good book, cards, or quiet activity to use alone or with friends during what little down time there is. Bring your *glasses* if you wear contacts. **No cell phones will be allowed, leave them at home!** The 'my cell phone is my camera' argument won't work either, don't try! Session 2 Campers: There is a TALENT SHOW and a DANCE so bring what you need to show off a little for these two evening activities.

*Especially bring (*school appropriate*) music you would like to hear at the dance!*

V. Recreational equipment and events: Basketball - Bring your own basketball. Swimming - daily and will be supervised by a certified life guard, bring suit and towel. Hiking (bring shoes other than flip-flops!), Volleyball, Frisbee, and other organized group activities.

VI. Musical Equipment: Instrument and bow in good repair. An extra set of strings is recommended. Repairs and replacement instruments can not be furnished at camp. Don't forget rosin and rock stops! **Have a name tag on your equipment** for easy identification. Solo materials and piano accompaniment (optional for chamber music/master class night), *wire music stand* (marked with name on both pieces) and pencil. **Bass students accustomed to sitting while playing should bring their own stool.**

All personal items must be labeled or tagged. Camp staff will not be responsible for lost items. Because of limited availability and the **no cell phone rule**, camp phone usage will be for emergencies only. Please do not plan on calling home.

VII. Registration Materials: *Balance of Camp Fee* due upon registration as well as completed and notarized Medical Care Authorization (attached). A notary will be available on site for a \$5 fee.

DO NOT BRING: FOOD, LARGE RADIOS OR CELL PHONES: All portable games or mp3 players should have an accompanying set of headphones. There will be plenty of food during meal and snack times. To prevent insect problems, no food should be kept in the rooms.

REMINDER: This is an educational as well as recreational camp. Any discipline problems encountered will warrant a phone call home to parents and could result in early dismissal.
